ABSTRACT

Librarians as well as their readers are facing huge demand for modernisation of library infrastructure. Decreasing state budget funds'allocations, limited funding from EU structural funds stipulate demand for the new financial resources to implement libraries'investment projects. Legal background for public and private partnership (PPP) was finally established in 2010 in Lithuania. Private investments are the new feasible way to implement infrastructure modernisation projects in Lithuanian libraries.
