1. orbit the skull

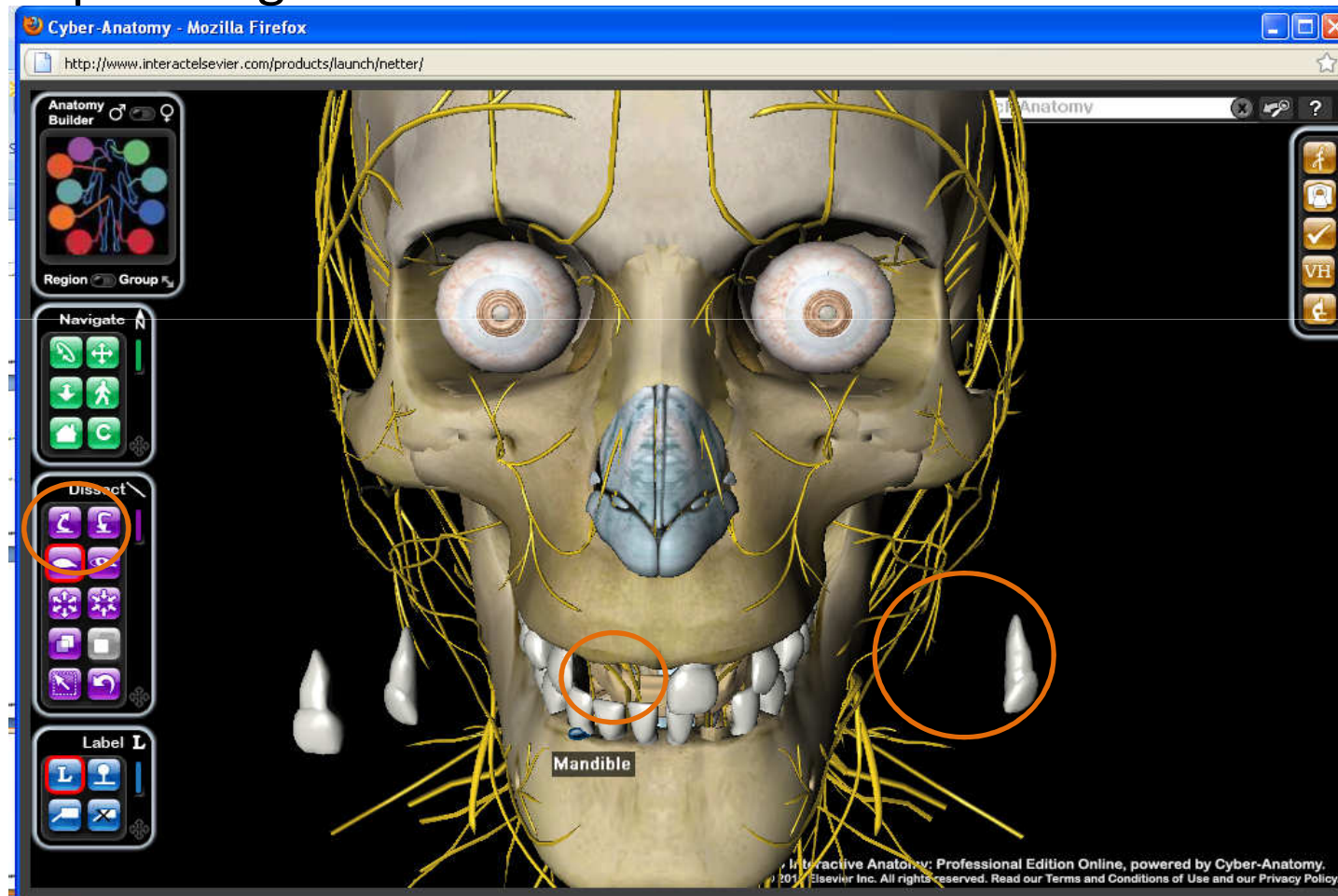
2. name the mandible



Example of peeling

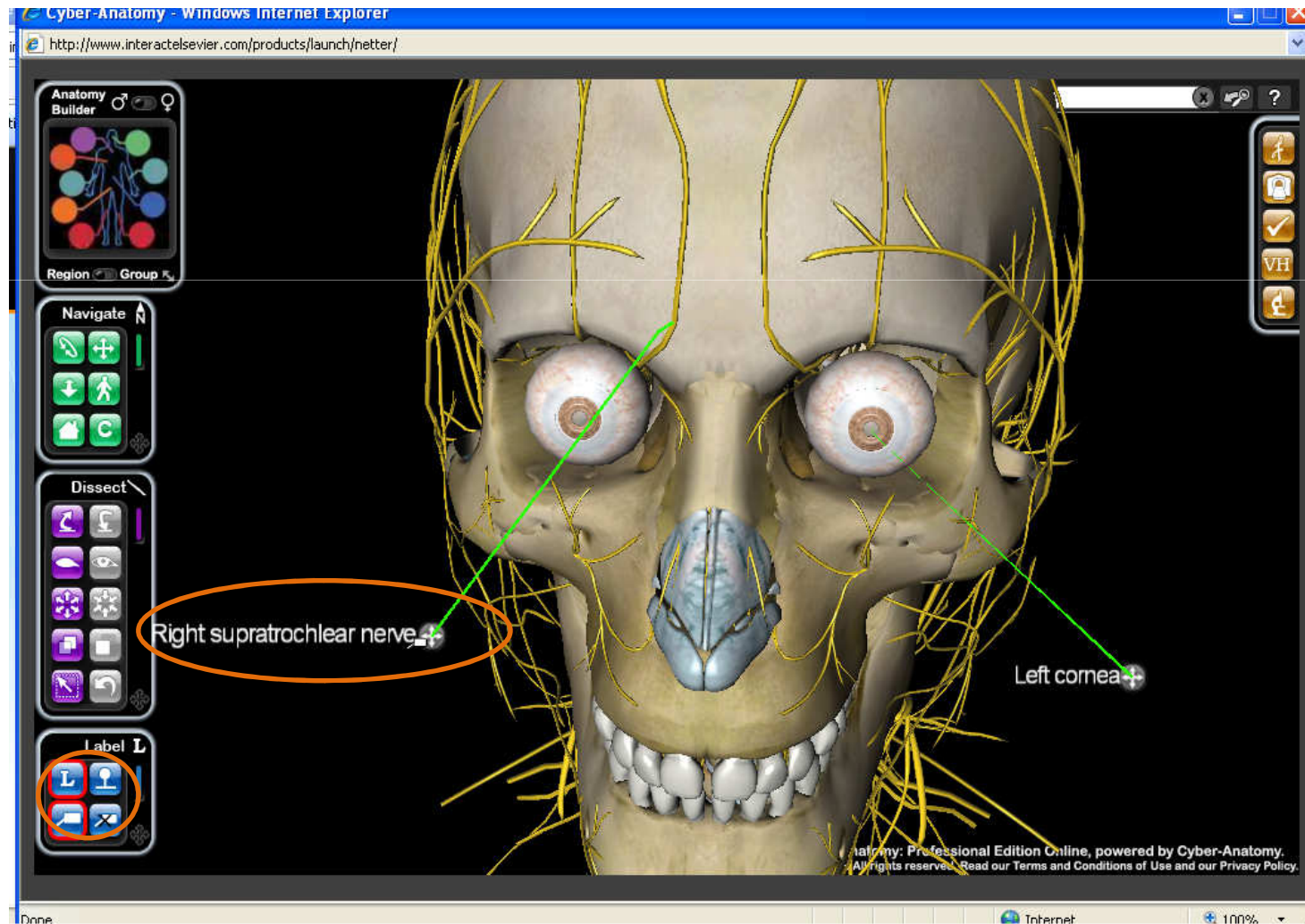
1. peel single tooth

2. hide the tooth



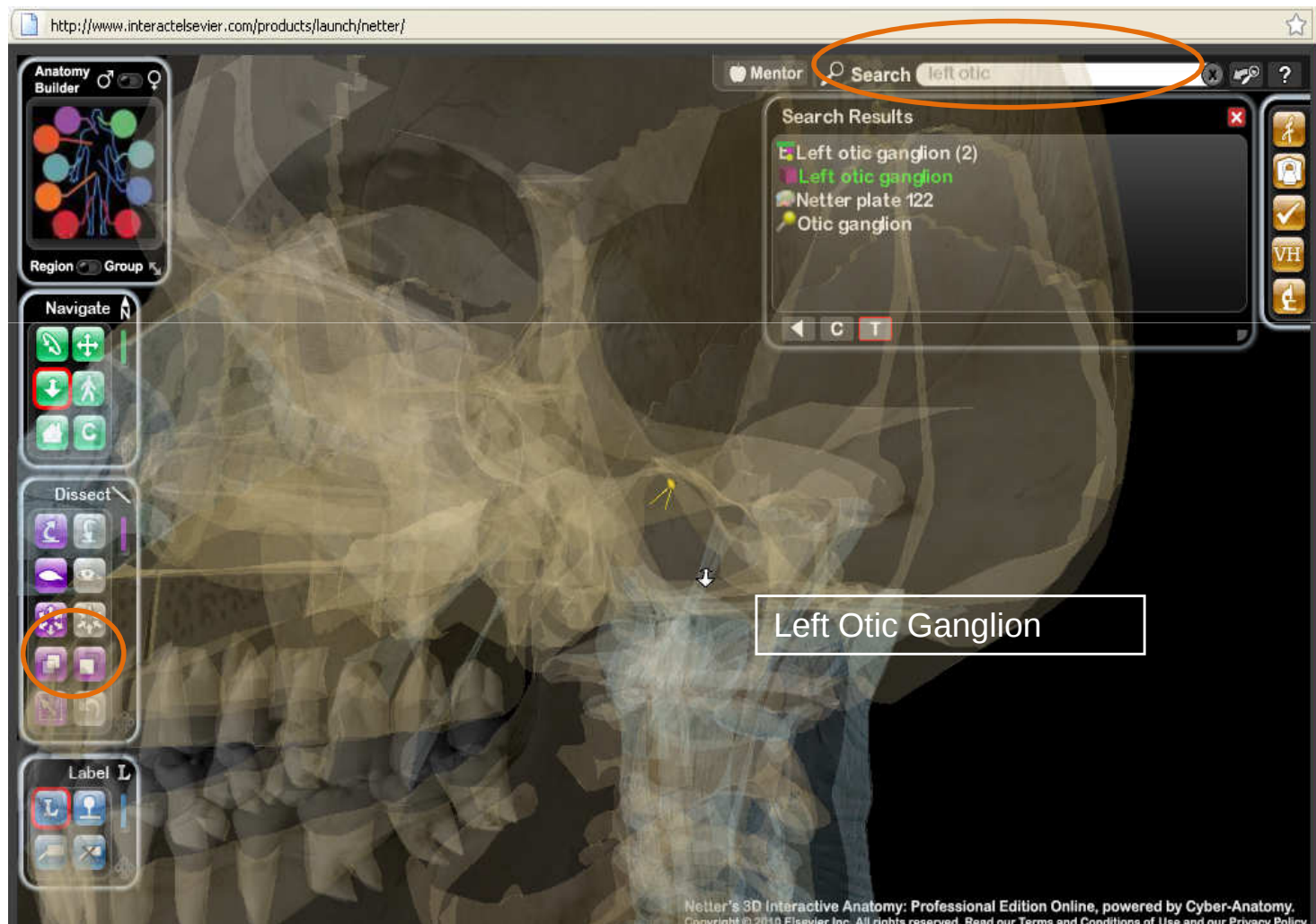
Example of marking with Latin

mark the nerves

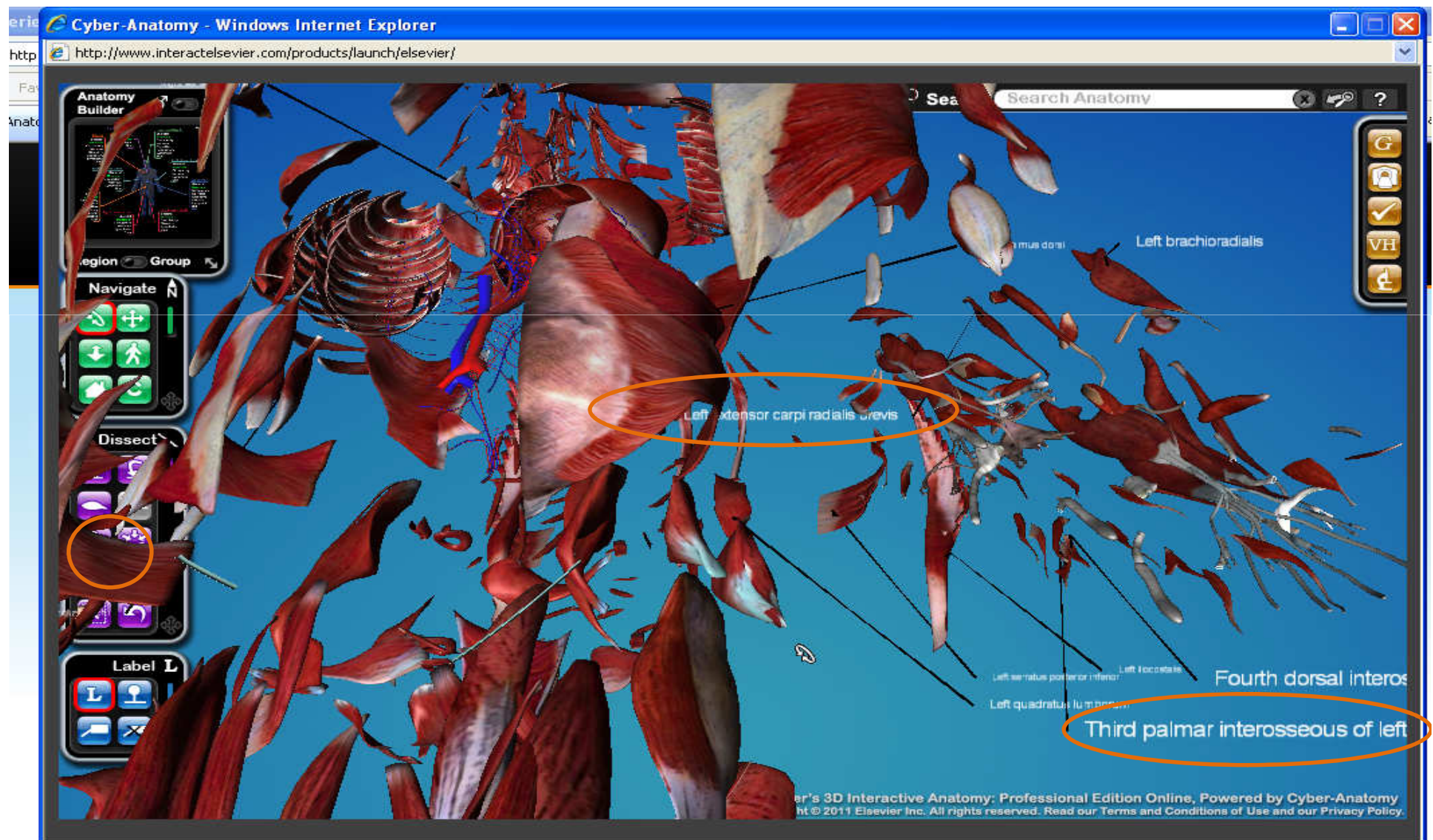


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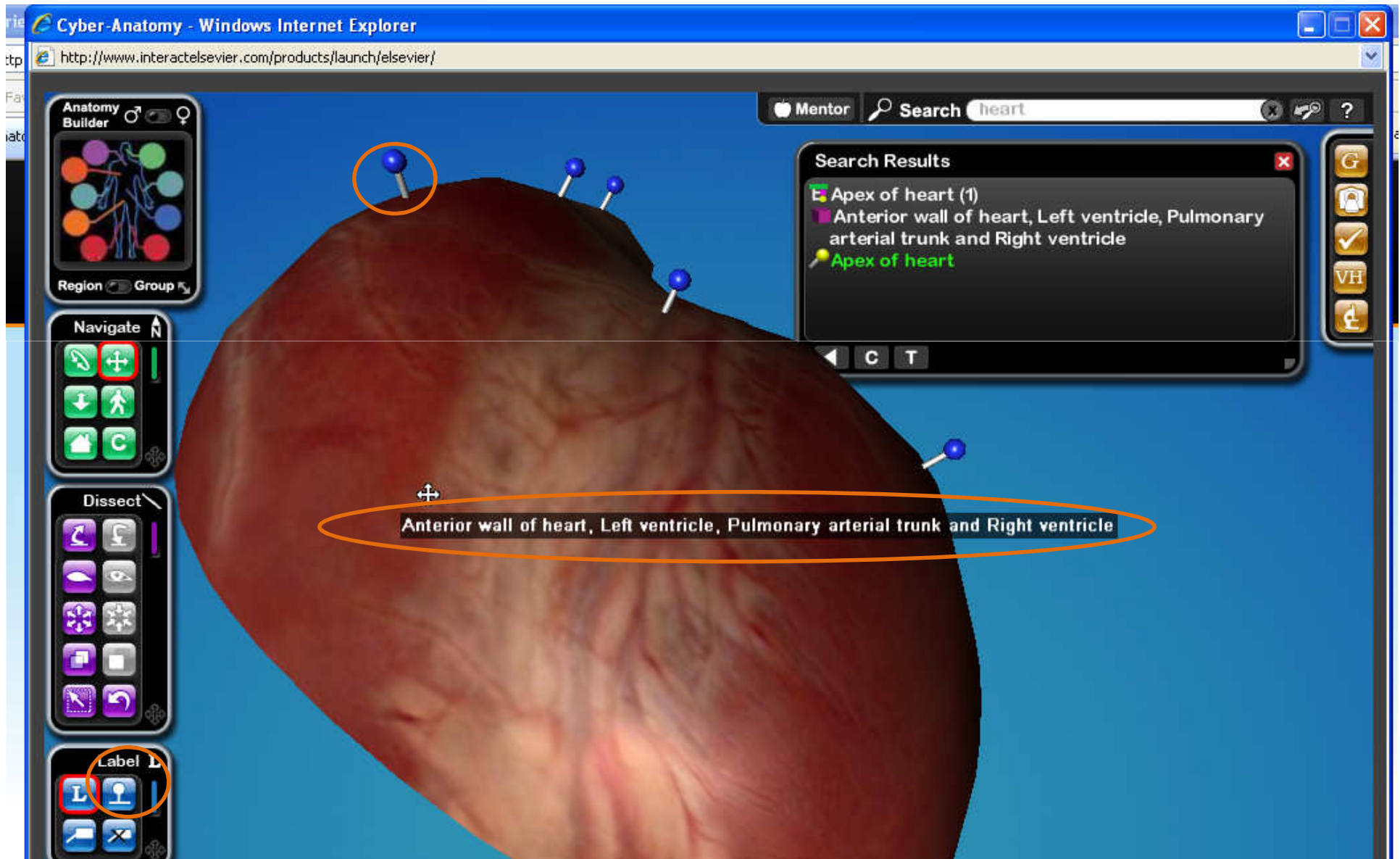

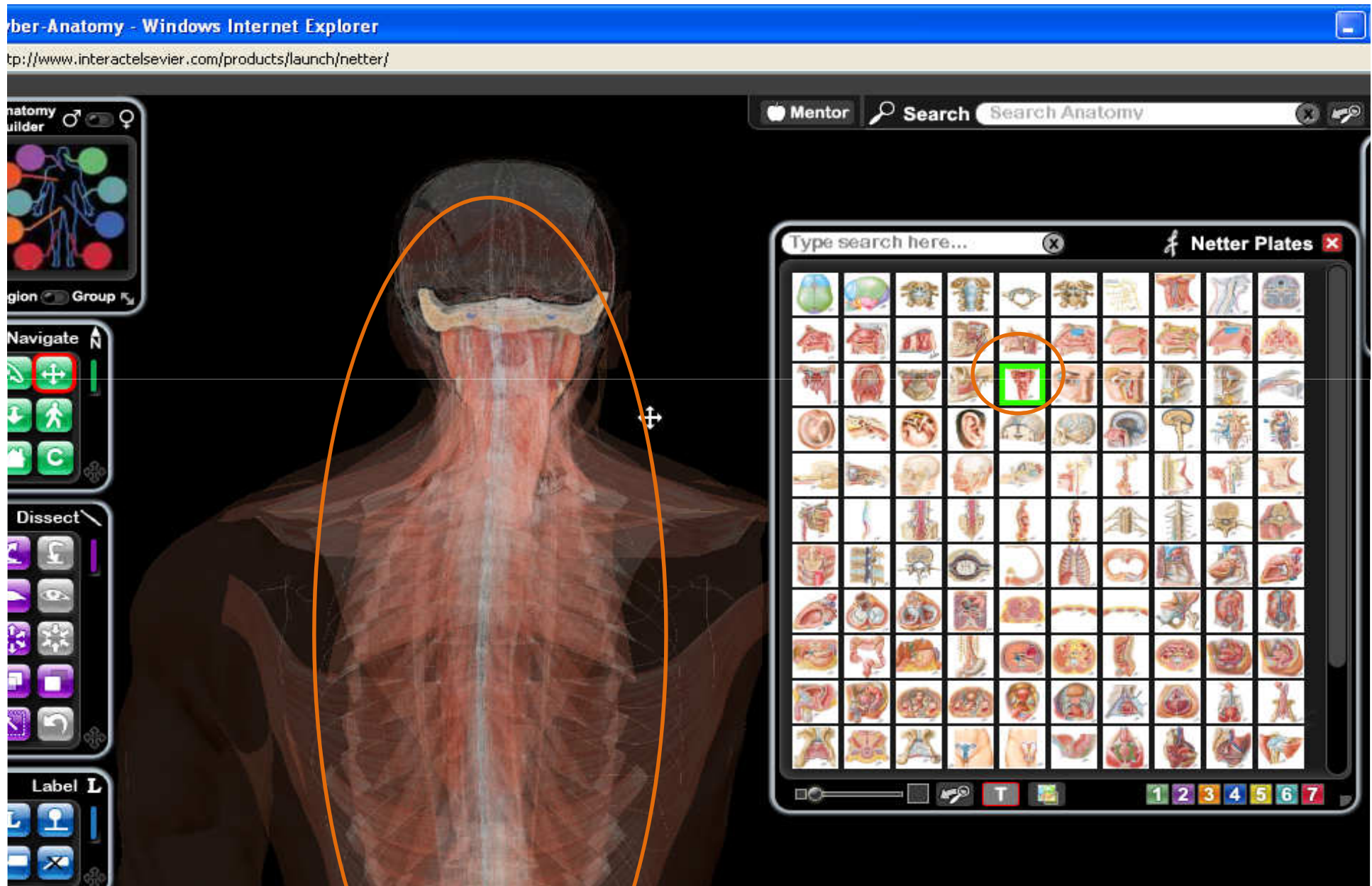
Example of 'exploding'



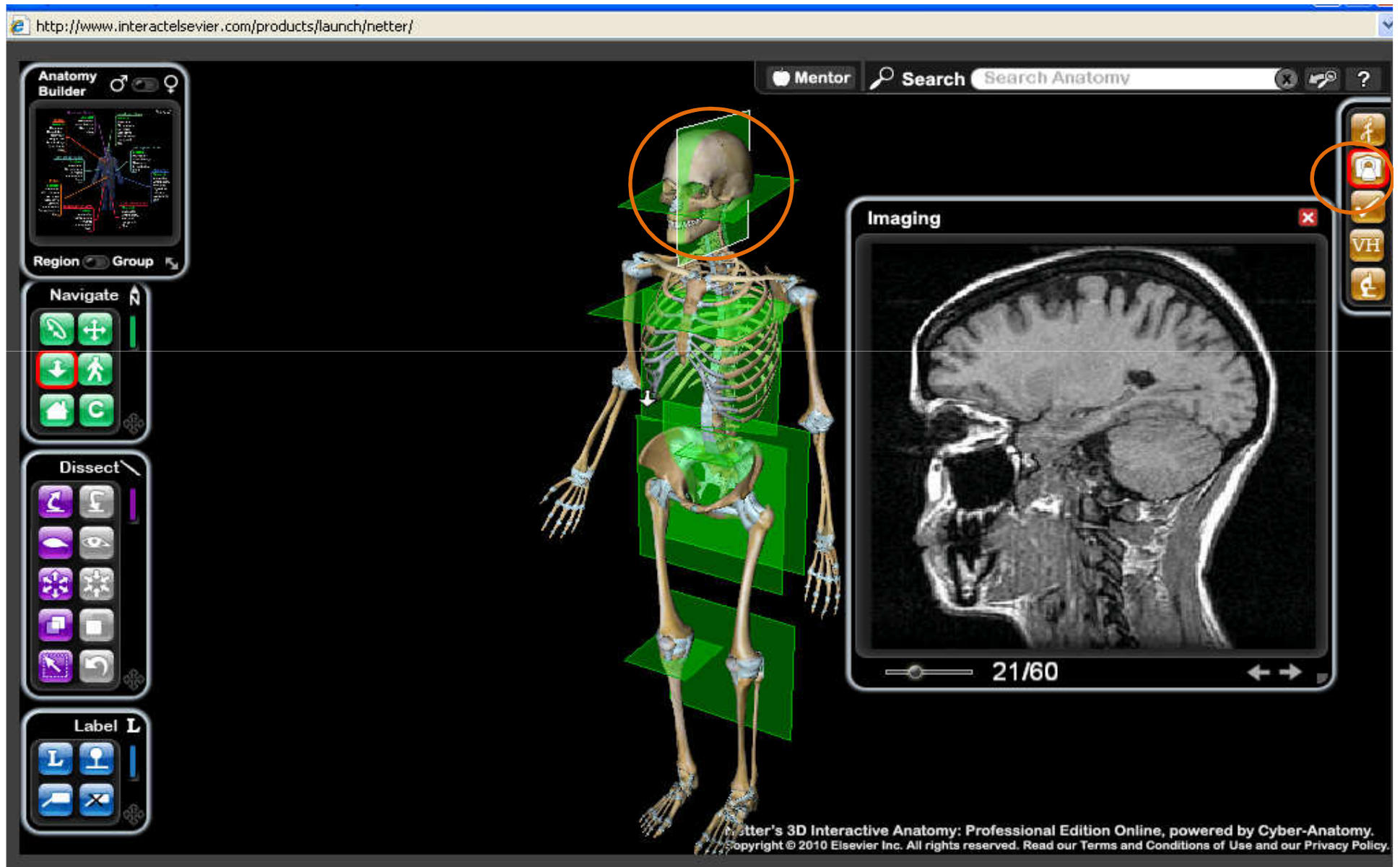

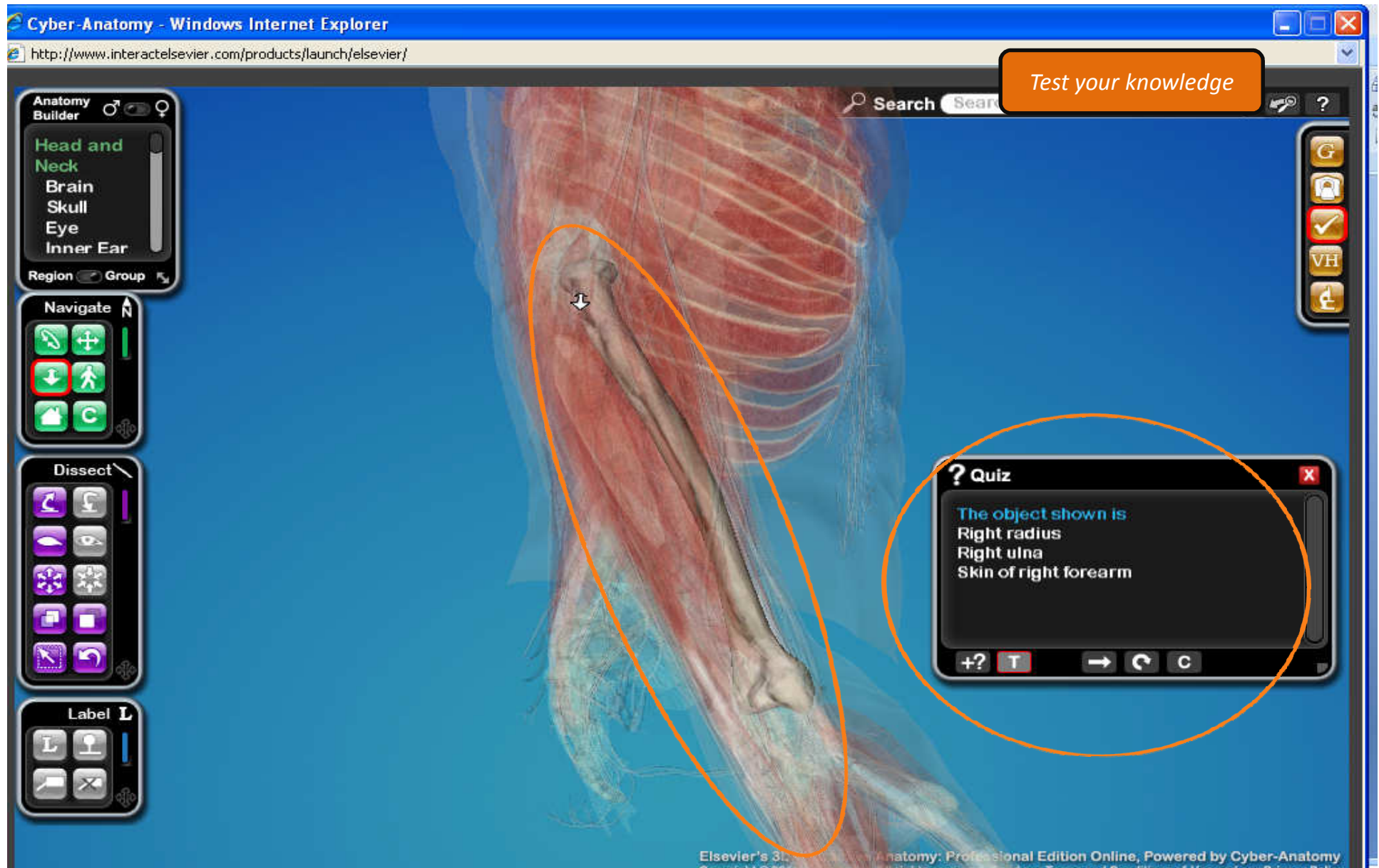
Example of Netter's atlas plates

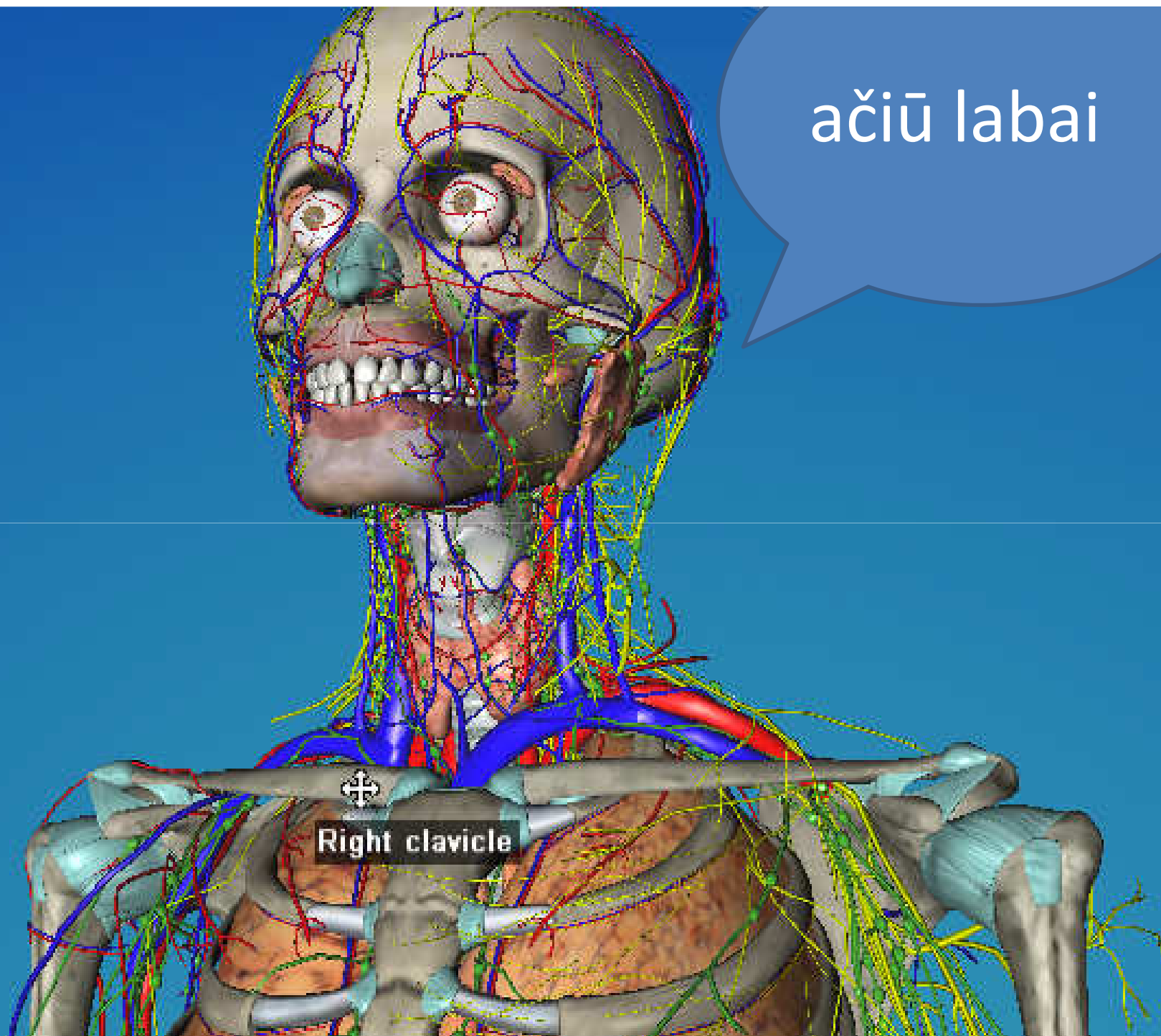
